Elliott and Madeline are building unicorns, will build practice pieces to see how actors use them.

AUNT BEAST will need masks for each ensemble member; can be different from one another. Elliott will work on those.






During the run, I had two big jobs: prepare a device for a pivotal vomiting scene (including mixing stage vomit), and clean stage vomit out of costumes during a quick exit and after each show. Technical challenges also included fabricating espresso and rum out of food coloring and ensuring the sanitary handling of a pan of clafouti that is eaten onstage.
